

Day 1/21 – Pray for your spouse.

If your spouse is a believer, pray he/she will grow in the Lord and have a deeper desire for His Word. If your spouse is an unbeliever, pray for his/her salvation. If you're not married, pray for your future spouse. If you don't plan to get married (or remarried), pray for a married couple you know. Ask God to strengthen their relationship and to draw them closer to Him.

Day 2/22 – Pray for your children.

Pray your children will put their trust in God and keep his commands. If you don't have children, pray for a niece, nephew, cousin, or a friend's child.

Day 3/23 – Pray for your pastors.

Pray for the Lord to be a shield around their families and protect them from the attacks of the enemy. Ask God to give them wisdom and boldness as they proclaim the gospel.

Day 4/24 – Pray for unsaved family and friends.

Pray they will realize their need to repent and be saved. Ask the Lord to rescue them from the kingdom of darkness and bring them into His kingdom.

Day 5/25 – Pray for a missionary or missionary family.

Ask God to give them strength and to multiply their efforts. Pray for financial provision for their work.

Day 6/26 – Pray for your country.

Pray for unbelievers to repent, for Christians to obey God's Word, and for revival to break out in the land.

Day 7/27 – Pray for a ministry.

Ask the Lord to give the leaders wisdom and discernment. Pray for financial provision and adequate resources to accomplish the work God has called them to do.

Day 8/28 – Pray for your neighbors.

Ask the Lord to meet their needs and to show you practical ways to demonstrate His love to them.

Day 9/29 – Pray for a family member or friend who is sick.

Ask the Lord to comfort him/her and to be especially near to him/her today. Pray for his/her physical strength and spiritual growth.

Day 10/30 – Pray for the leaders of your country.

Pray they will honor the Lord in their personal lives and make decisions according to the Bible. Ask God to draw unsaved politicians to repentance and to strengthen the hearts of believers who hold public office.

Day 11/31 – Pray for a teacher.

Ask God to fill him/her with joy, patience, and wisdom. Pray he/she will trust in the Lord for strength and endurance to finish out the school year strong.

Day 12/32 – Pray for someone struggling in his/her marriage.

Ask God to give him/her a renewed sense of hope. Pray for open communication, forgiveness, and reconciliation.

Day 13/33 – Pray for a military family with a spouse who is serving overseas.

Pray God will give the husband and wife strength during this time of separation. Pray they will both draw close to God and grow in their knowledge of His Word. Ask God to comfort their children. Thank the Lord for being a shield around the family and for protecting them.

Day 14/34 – Pray for a widow or widower.

Ask the Lord to fill the deepest desires of his/her heart. Pray for God's comfort and peace to be present when he/she struggles with sadness and loneliness.

Day 15/35 – Pray for your children's spouses (or their future spouses).

Pray for an uncompromising commitment to purity. Ask God to give them a strong desire to know Him and walk in His ways. If you don't have children, pray for a friend's child and his/her spouse.

Day 16/36 – Pray for unsaved family members.

Pray their eyes will be opened to their sinful condition and need for salvation. Ask God to plant seeds of faith in their hearts. Thank the Lord for the work He's doing in their lives to bring them to repentance.

Day 17/37 – Pray for your church.

Ask God to pour out his Spirit on your church in a supernatural way. Pray for a burden to reach the lost.

Day 18/38 – Pray for someone who is divorced or is going through a divorce.

Ask God to fill him/her with joy. Pray he/she will not be anxious but will trust in God to guide his/her steps.

Day 19/39 – Pray for the people in a foreign country.

Ask God to place a specific country on your heart. Pray the people will find hope in the Lord and put their trust in His Word.

Day 20/40 – Pray for Christians enduring persecution.

Thank God for being a shield around them. Pray they will stand strong in the Lord and not be afraid. Ask God to give them boldness and the strength to endure.
